- 1 . The Chief Finish Judge has the authority to:

 - a. Once the order of finish in an electronically operated event has been completed by the Chief Finish Judge, he shall be responsible for recording those placings in the appropriate box on the time card.

 - b. It is the responsibility of the Chief Finish Judge to notify the referee when there is a tie for last place or second alternate for a final or consolation final.

 - c. The Chief Finish Judge shall:
 1. notify the recording room to delay publishing results when a problem such as a swim-off or a protest has occurred;
 2. arrange swim-offs with coaches and swimmers and notify the referee;
 3. endeavour to record the order of finish in electronically timed meets;
 4. ensure that all DQ's, Ties, and DNF's are appropriately flagged for computer operators;
 5. before results are posted, sign the print out of the finish order of each event after ensuring that it is correct;
 6. notify the Chief Timekeeper of the repeated discrepancies in times or recording of times in specific lanes.
 7. ensure that times achieved by swimmers who are subsequently disqualified are not published.
